The words of the homeless people portrayed in the pictures will be spoken by members of the Glastonbury-based Meeting House Poets. The reception, also featuring music, refreshments and displays, is one of several activities associated with an exhibition of photographs from Anderson's book "Homeless Souls" (Antrim House, 2009) running from January 21 to February 18 at the church. The show may be viewed daily during church open hours and at the reception.
